This report aims to inform the dialog about water system investment priorities by providing quantitative evidence about the magnitude of water infrastructure renewal needs in BC.

Join us for a "sneak peek" of the study results, which examine financial data from 162 municipalities around BC.

- How are we doing on recovering the "full cost" of providing water and wastewater services?
- How much will it cost to replace water and sewer assets when those assets have come to the end of their useful life?
- How well are we doing on building sufficient financial capacity to replace those assets?
- What does this mean for municipalities, elected officials and the public?

These questions and more will be answered as John Weninger, Chair of the BCWWA Infrastructure Management Committee, together with Tanja McQueen, CEO of the BCWWA, present the study results and respond to your questions.
