Lost Rivers (CatBird Films - view trailer) (full documentary 72 minutes)

takes us across the globe, retracing the history of lost urban rivers by plunging into archival maps and going under-ground with clandestine urban explorers. We'll search for the disappeared Petite Rivière St-Pierre in Montreal, the River Tyburn in London, the Saw Mill River in New York, and the Bova-Celato River in Bresica.
