**Park(ing) Day** is an international movement that encourages the community to transform single use parking stalls into shared parkettes. It is a way to re-imagine community space within the urban context. The movement started in 2005 in San Francisco – the idea has sparked internationally. On **September 20<sup>th</sup>** parking stalls reserved for stationary cars will be enlivened around the world.

### Activating your Park!



#### Examples of activities & uses:

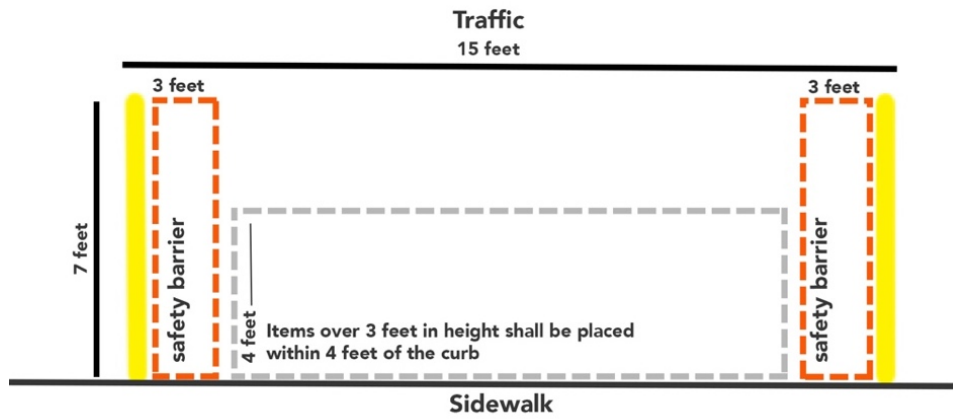
- Tables, chairs, benches
- Art installation
- Craft, games or other cultural activities
- Artificial turf, rugs, carpets, blankets, or similar surface coverings
- Informative signs or displays
- Think of community and shared use

#### Restricted activities & uses (consider safety for all)

- Banners, balloons, lights and sound
- Sidewalk storage or activities onto sidewalk area
- Charcoal grills (must obtain Fire Marshall Permit for use of propane)
- Vending or merchandise display
- Loose or uncovered material (like sand or gravel)

## Setting up

For the duration of **Park(ing) Day**, installations should not exceed 1 parking stall.



### Remember:

- Always keep sidewalk and travel lanes clear
- All loading and unloading activities must ensure pedestrian and vehicle mobility
- Activities in your park shouldn't distract motorists
- To make sure that your park doesn't impede sight lines, keep anything taller than 3 feet within 4 feet of the curb



## Location

To create a festive environment and to ensure ideal visibility, the focus will be on the stalls along **Commercial Street** between Museum Way and Wallace Street.

Once your concept has been accepted, we will reserve a stall for you within the designated area. **You are responsible for paying for your own Park(ing) stall - \$2.50/2hour**
