The Park Planning and Design Manager will be instrumental in leading the City's park planning process to undertake projects and deliver plans and policies related to the development and implementation of the City's parkland acquisition strategy and park improvement program. The role will be responsible for navigating capital project delivery and planning processes and will be working closely with our Strategic and Capital Projects team to deliver exceptional parks projects. As well, the Park Planning and Design Manager will partner with the Development Planning division to ensure transit-oriented development in the City incorporates exceptional park spaces and elements.

Our next Park Planning and Design Manager will look forward to setting team priorities that are aligned with City and Departmental priorities as well as develop and implement processes, policies and tools to maintain high quality planning and design standards, monitor project progress and control spending in order to ensure efficient and effective use of allocated funds and approved budgets. Overseeing the Park Planning team will require considerable independent leadership, innovation and judgment and requires a professional with excellent interpersonal, communication and presentation skills.
