We are SO excited to announce that we are collaborating with Mark Albany of the Songhees Nation to host another Ləkwəŋən (Lekwungen) walking tour this fall. This tour will take place on Friday, September 22nd from 1:30pm – 4:00pm and will allow participants to explore Victoria from the Ləkwəŋən (Lekwungen) point of view, learning about the land, culture, and the spirit of its people.

The tour will begin beside the Mungo Martin Longhouse (475 Belleville Street), and will end at Songhees Point (50 Songhees Point). Following the tour, we invite you to join us at Smiths Pub (777 Courtney Street) for a planners social from 4:00pm – 6:00pm. Appetizers will be provided and no registration is required.
