About the Role:

We're a small municipality with significant development interest (hotels, multi-family, mixed-use, subdivisions). Reporting directly to the Director of Planning and Development, a big part of your role will be processing land use/development applications, you will also be tasked with co-creating and interpreting bylaws; policies and regulations; researching and reporting; public consultation; and related work as assigned.

You'll assist in current and long-range planning processes, applying your knowledge and skills in the collection, analysis, and interpretation of data for municipal studies and projects. Over the next few years, the Town will be working on the following new bylaws: DCC bylaw, official community plan, zoning, floodplain, subdivision, and development servicing. The Town will also strive towards implementing it's short-term rental regulations, affordable housing strategy and transportation plan.

Ideal Candidate:

We need a superstar communicator with an enthusiastic and positive attitude.
