- Ability to express ideas effectively, orally, and in writing, and excellent organizational, report writing and presentation skills.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to work with external stakeholders and internal stakeholders, and maintain effective working relationships in a multi-disciplinary team environment.
- Strong negotiating skills to resolve conflicts and to achieve The City's strategic objectives
- Ability to read architectural and site plans, and perform various mathematical calculations to determine compliance and/or various relaxations of code and bylaw requirements.
- Ability to work in a high-paced environment, with constant interruptions, adjustments to work schedules, and a high consequence of error.
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Office.
- Ability to obtain membership in the Alberta Development Officer's Association.
- Valid class 5 driver's license and the use of their vehicle for business use.
