

Senior Land Use Planner Dawson Regional Planning Commission

The Yukon Land Use Planning Council seeks a Senior Land Use Planner to assist the Dawson Regional Planning Commission in the preparation of a recommended regional land use plan for the Dawson Region. The role of the Senior Land Use Planner is to assist the Commission in completing a Draft Land Use Plan; managing the Draft Plan public engagement process and developing a Recommended Plan. The plan will represent a major milestone in reconciliation and the implementation of the Yukon First Nation Land Claim Agreements. The Senior Land Use Planner works under a collaborative supervision arrangement with the Chair of Dawson Regional Planning Commission and the Director of the Yukon Land Use Planning Council.

Required Qualifications:

- Knowledge of the Dawson Regional Planning Commission's regional planning process
- Successful completion of a land and resource management, geography or planning-related postsecondary education program;
- Experience in all aspects of project management in a land use planning context;
- Experience in co-ordinating multi-disciplinary teams in the application of land and resource management;
- Experience working with a variety of people, communities, boards, agencies or commissions with potentially differing views, values and beliefs.

Demonstrated Skills and Suitability:

- Tact and diplomacy when engaging with public boards, governments, and/or public and stakeholders:
- Organizational skills and the ability to manage within critical deadlines;
- Regional planning or similar resource management planning;
- Communication skills, both oral and written with an emphasis on concise and accurate writing;

- Supervision of support staff;
- Knowledge of Yukon First Nations Final Agreements.
